-Major Elder reported on recent crimes in the neighborhood:

- There was an attempted kidnapping of a 9 year-old girl at Dreux Ave and Venus St
- An attempted armed robbery of a woman walking her dog occurred at Selma and Arts

-Major asked that people lock their cars!!! 70% of robberies are because people leave their doors open.

- Moving crime camera from Franklin and Mirabeau is dead in the water—until the city hires someone to monitor the cameras

- Noise ordinance needs to be revamped. Needs to go through City Council. Major Elder states that basically it is unenforceable at this time
- If you see something suspicious please call, they never feel that it is a wasted call. They would rather have people call than not. Every time someone is stopped there is a field interview card written and recorded
